

## DIVING IN CYPRUS

Cyprus offers a myriad of year-round diving opportunities whether you are a complete beginner and want just a taste of the mysteries of the deep or an experienced diver seeking the thrill of wreck diving.



Cyprus is surrounded by the calm waters of the Mediterranean making it a perfect destination for scuba diving and snorkeling, offering highly qualified PADI and BSAC instructors. The coast of Paphos in particular offers numerous diving and snorkeling sites and the Larnaca area boasts one of the worlds' top ten dive sites, the Zenobia wreck.

Considered the islands most outstanding dive site, the Zenobia was a Swedish ferry loaded with trucks and trailers that sank off the coast of Larnaca on its maiden voyage in 1980. The 197 metre-long wreck lies at a depth of 42 metres.



Whatever your diving level take to the waters and explore sea caves, discover Roman artifacts and enjoy a close encounter with the wonderful array of marine life. With water temperatures ranging from 25°C in the summer to 15°C in the winter and almost year-round sunshine, Cyprus offers one of the longest diving seasons in the Mediterranean. With no dangerous tides or currents and crystal clear waters, Cyprus is the ideal place for discovering the magic world under the sea.

## **Diving Courses**

### **Discover Scuba Diving**

For a first taste of scuba diving, why not take a half day beginners course. The training starts with a short video explaining the basics and then our instructors will brief you and help you set up your scuba gear. You will soon find yourself in the water practicing the skills you have learned and enjoying your first sea dive.

This course is suitable for children over the age of 10

### **PADI Scuba Diving Course**

This course consists of the first three segments of theory and pool sessions of the Open Water Course, and the first two dives in the Sea.

The Scuba Diver Course will allow you to dive to a maximum of 12 meters under the supervision of a Dive Professional.

This certification does not expire and allow you to upgrade to Open Water Diver at any time.



### **PADI Scuba Diving Upgrade**

Second step for Scuba Divers! This Segment of training will cover the 2 extra sessions of Theory and Pool training in addition to the last two dives in the open water, to become qualified as an Open Water Diver

### **PADI Open Water Referral**

After completing the Theory and Pool sessions at home, you can come and complete the 4 training dives in the Open Water with us in the warm waters of Cyprus.

Your Open Water Qualification will be issued from our dive centre at the end of training.

### **PADI Open Water**

Your First Full Qualification!

This course allows you to dive independently to a maximum of 18 meters with a Dive Buddy. This Course consist of 5 Theory Modules, 5 Pool Sessions and 4 Open Water Dives. The qualification does not expire but it is recommended to take a refresher dive if you have not been diving for 6 months or longer.

### **National Geographic Open Water Diver**

An Open Water Diver Course with a twist! In this fantastic program, that only few selected centers around the world can teach, you will top up the knowledge and skills of the open water course with some extra challenges specifically created to bring out the Explorer in you.

### **PADI Adventure Diver**

Extend your Diving Skills! Take part in one of a wide selection of Adventure Dives and see what more can you do underwater. These dives will also account for your Advanced Diver Certification and the relative specialty certification

### **PADI Advanced Open Water**

For something extra we offer 5 Dives in different areas of interest, Two Core Dives ,Navigation and Deep, and three Elective to choose from the list below : Aware, Boat, Dry Suit, DPV, EANx, Fish ID, Multilevel, Naturalist, Night, PPB, Photo, Search & Recovery Wreck, and many others

### **Advanced Open Water Upgrade**

Adding only two more dives to your Adventure Diver Course, you will become an Advanced Diver provided that amongst your 5 dives you have logged Navigation and a Deep Dive.

### **National Geographic Speciality**

For those of you that want to become National Geographic Divers but have already a Qualification. You too can get this prestigious Certification by attending the two required dives, and recording your experiences to provide a full report of the underwater environment where you dived.



### **Emergency First Response**

EFR / CFC: The Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) and Emergency First Response Secondary Care (First Aid) and the Emergency First Response Care For Children courses teach you how to provide emergency care for someone in need. These courses make learning easy by providing a non stressful environment in which you practice and apply emergency care skills.

### **DAN O2 Provided**

The DAN provider course is a 6 hour course which teaches basic oxygen provision skills. A fun and practical course, it familiarizes the student with all oxygen delivery set-ups and includes realistic scenarios.

### **PADI Rescue Diver**

The Rescue Diver course is a crucial phase of your training, in fact it helps develop your ability to identify and prevent problems, as well as solving them if they arise. The course structure and organization has been planned to help learning and to give the candidate the proper state of mind to deal with different kind of emergencies in the water and at the surface.

### **PADI Dive Master**

This is the first step in becoming a dive pro. During the PADI Dive Master Course you will be learning how to function as an instructional assistant, a dive guide, a counsellor and much more. Your dive theory knowledge will be at a professional level and your dive skills to a demonstration quality. As a Dive Master you are an important asset to any diving centre and diving instructor.
